Solution

Central Group were tasked with collaborating to build a new home for Southmead Hospital Charity. This was achieved with an architectural quality that enhances its surroundings. Partnering with a trusted modular company, Central delivered this fantastic-looking project within budget.

Central installed an Equitone UK rainscreen cladding system creating a dark grey uniform aesthetic. This was a high-performance, premium, fibre cement panel. Giving the full creative scope of modern cladding systems with the performance levels required for contemporary buildings.

The building has a carefully detailed façade, combining architectural precision with stringent technical requirements. Along with the Modular substructure we were able to deliver this project on time, minimising the disruption to the NHS.

Our Work

The timber battens were vertically installed onto counter battens as part of the built-up cladding system incorporating helping hand bracketry. This is due to the void that had to be formed for concealed rainwater goods and the modular structure that sits outbound of the internal wall.
